Engage week

As with the start of each half-term, this week saw each class launching their new topic in a variety of fun, creative and engaging ways.

Willow Class this week, have launched their exciting new topic, 'Dinosaur Planet', by going on a Dino Hunt, using maps and clues to find fossils, dinosaur eggs, footprints and a dinosaur. Our group winners showed great team-working skills and we all had a fantastic morning!

Beech Class topic is 'Towers, Tunnels and Turrets. They have tested their fortress walls against attack! In groups, they built a castle wall from wooden blocks they investigated how the weight of a projectile thrown at the castle wall affects the damage done to it. They tested it using projectiles such as balls of scrunched paper, play dough, clay, and tennis balls. They assessed which projectile did the most damage to the wall and explained that it worked so well because it was the heaviest and hardest. They also talked about why it wasn't a fair test because they all threw the projectiles at different forces.

Birch class have experimented with a multitude of artistic mediums to create illustrations for their topic 'Blue Abyss'.

Maple class have been looking at contour lines on maps—we created our own 3D models based on Alchemy Island!
