As you all know it has become increasingly difficult for Headteachers to grant authorised leave for family holidays due to reissued guidance from the DfE stating that leave may only be authorised in 'exceptional circumstances'. The situation has been further compounded by the new definition of 'persistent absence' as 10% and not 15% as it always has been.

So, whilst De and I often understand your requests for leave we are limited in what we can authorise. It becomes almost impossible for us to grant authorised leave during term-time if all you write on the form is 'Holiday'. We need to have a meaningful explanation in order to be more flexible with the 'exceptional' definition. It is also worth mentioning that if you have tried to book the majority of your holiday across a school break but you need the days immediately before and after to travel to airports or recover from late flights then, as we live so far from large, international airports, it is worth citing this on your request form.

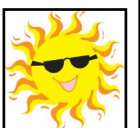
Pupil Data Privacy Information




Please note lunches are not provided – please supply picnic lunch.

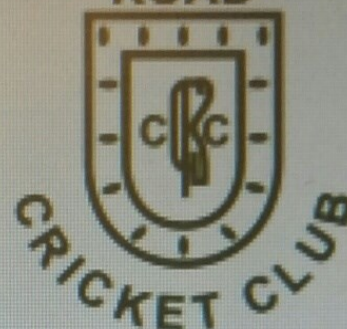
