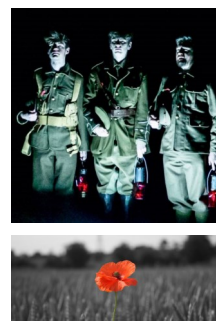
Attendance of the Week

All KS2 classes took part in Bench ball PE lessons this week and we had some very competitive matches.

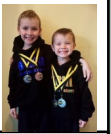
Although it is a very simplistic game and has very basic rules, it proved to be very popular with all year groups.

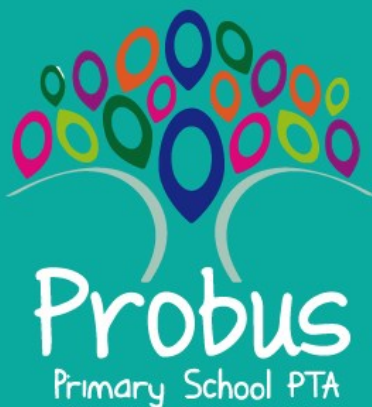
