## What we are learning this term:

### Science

In Science, we will be continuing our learning about everyday materials. We will be building up to designing and making mini houses, choosing suitable materials and testing whether they can withstand "wind" using a hairdryer!

### Religious Education (RE)

Our big question in RE this term is: "What does it mean to belong to a faith community?" We will explore this through stories, discussion and reflection.

### Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about maps and how they help us find places and understand our surroundings.
