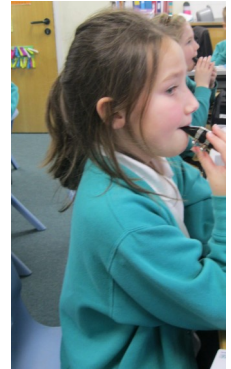


Music!

We need you to bake, bring and buy as many cakes as you can! Children can bring in a maximum of £1.

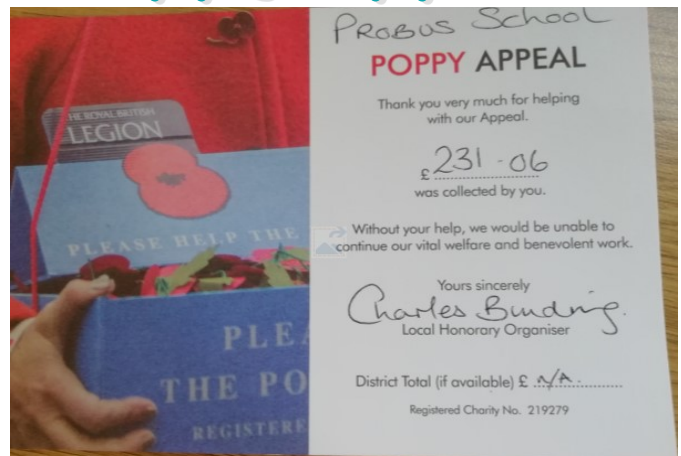
