To launch our topic of Predator this half term, Rowan were really lucky to have the Screech Owl Sanctuary to visit on Tuesday. They brought along 3 feathery friends with them, a tawny, spectacle and barn owl. The children were all able to stroke the tame birds of prey and ask important questions to help them understand just how these particular predators catch their prey. I'm sure if you ask your children about the barn owl boogie, why you can only stroke a barn owl on the tummy, why some owls have different coloured and sized eyes and how spectacle owls cunningly overcome snakes they will all be able to tell you!

Birch Class - Investigating the invisible beach



The children of Birch received a message in a bottle hidden in a micro beach. Their message came from the 'Whatifs' who needed help to convince the 'Justsos' to leave shells and pebbles on the beach. The children worked with different equipment to magnify the message and start their investigations. They used microscopes, data loggers, thermometers and research to convince the Justsos that the invisible beach was an amazing place. They even had tinctures that helped them gain the power of super sight and shrink-ability!

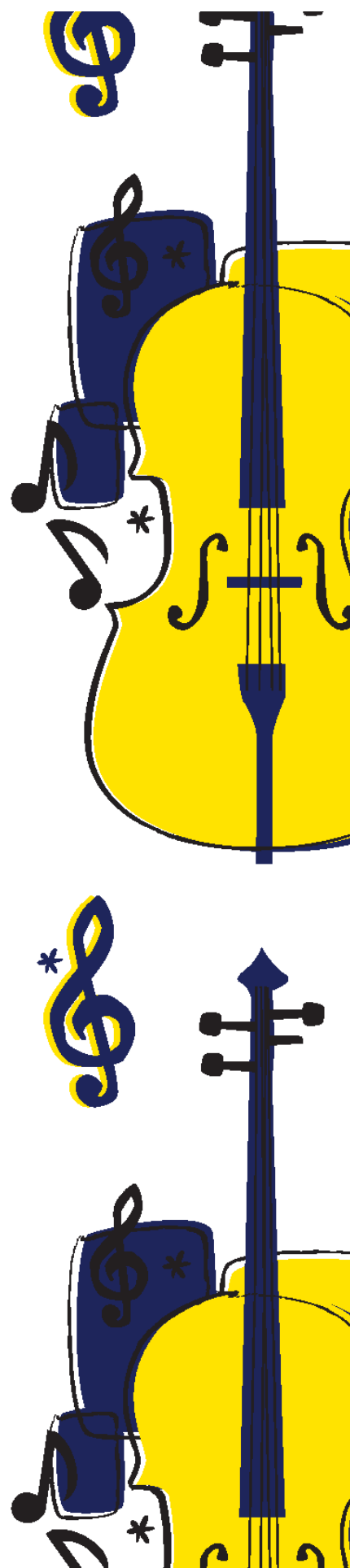
